

MINUTES FROM HSA GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

February 1, 2018

Meeting was called to order by the Commodore at: 6:30 PM

OFFICERS' REPORTS:

1. COMMODORE: Peter Burg presented a twelve (12) item agenda.
 - A. The new Vice Commodore of Events is Jen Kobrick
 - B. Rob Hall asked that HSA consider adding a canopy over the pier landing area.
 - C. The dock repair was suspended early today because there weren't sufficient stringers to continue.
 - D. The two remaining Catalina 25 were crushed yesterday
 - E. A Catalina 22 with trailer has been inspected, considered repairable (bulkhead, mast cradle, hull, chain plate to bulkhead) and approved as an acceptable donation. This addition would result in one Catalina 25, two Catalina 22s, and a Renken 19
 - F. The BoD approved the Catalina 22 donation. Greg Pop donated a Force-5 that is race ready.
 - G. The Catalina 25 is getting the swing keel attachment repaired. The deck to hull separation is smaller than the Pearson 30 damage from hurricane Matthew.
 - H. Ernst and Melinda are expecting the Power Squadron to donate a Sunfish
 - I. The dock repair workers used their front loader to scrape the sand and rocks off the ramp and beach areas.
 - J. Some portion of the dock planks should be removed in anticipation of tropical storm to come and prevent damage. Plank screws should remain flush and not be countersunk.
 - K. Barbara Kelly, who oversees the grant will be getting photos of the progress.
 - L. Steve C., HYS, is considering getting a soda vending machine

 - A. The John Deere tractor was modified to plow sand from the beach ramp.

 - A. The Sunfish rack repairs are completed
